This agreement made this 8th, day of January, A.D. 1909, between Cal. W. Washington of said County and State and George L. English, of Shelby North Carolina.

WITNESSETH:

That we parties hereto hereby agree that they will and do hereby accept as the boundaries between their respective tracts of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, South-Carolina, the lines determined this day by a survey made by James P. Willis and also the corners, which are as follows:

Beginning at a stone, Chas.L. Ashmores, Cal or Col W. Washington's and George L. English's corner and running; thence S. 27 E. 2.20 chains to a stone; thence S. 44 E. 11.20 chains to a white-oak; thence S. 10 E. 2.35 chains to a stone; thence S. 38 E. 2.69 chains to a stone; thence S. 11-2/3 E. 5.05 chains to a stone; thence S. 62-3/4 W. 6.00 chains to a stone, formerly a spanish-oak-stump, T.M. Griffin's Cal.W. Washington's and George L.-English's corner.
