That at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation. That the said organization holds or desires to hold, property incommon for a religious educational, social, fraternal, charitable, or other eleemosynary purpose or any two or more of said purposes and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members, other wise than is above stated or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three' days notice in the Daily News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed:-

And, whereas, that said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed; First: Their names and residences are as above given.

Second: The name of the proposed Corporation is THE SOUTH CAROLINA CHILDRENS' HOME SOCIETY Third: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is Greenville, S.C.

Fourth: The purpose of the said proposed corporation is to receive into legal custody and provide for destitute, neglected, ill-treated and abandoned and orphaned white children; to seek out suitable family homes for those that are normal and protect their interests by proper contract and otherwise and to perform such other acts as will tend to improve the conditions of the above mentioned classes of children.
