He hereby turns over and delivers to his wife Mrs. Nannie Henson all and every article of personal property which he may be possessed of to keep and do with as she please, he surrendering to her all right and title to any part of same, he solemnly swearing he will forever defend to her the absolute right to the property against any claim that he made or set up by either himself or any other person or persons, she having paid to him the full value of same.
