Erwin in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sell and convey unto the said W.A. Erwin, his successors or assigns the right to back water in, through, over and upon my lands on said River in said County and State, bounded by large of J.L. French

provided, however, if dem or dams cause water to back over my said land I am to be paid \$50.00 dollars per acre for all that are so permanently covered and to safety line or I am to be paid \$25.00 dollars per acre for all above described land and I hereby acknowledge said sum in full satisfaction to me of any damage I may sustain or which may result to my lands by reason of any dam the said W.A. Erwin, his successors or assigns, may erect at said Mill or at Johnson or Gambrell Shoals.

To have and to hold the same right, power and easements to said W.A. Erwin, his successors or assigns, forever provided however, this agreement is made upon the express condition that I reserve the right to cultivate all my lands not used for the said purposes, or bought and if at the expiration of two years from the date hereof, natice is not given to me of intention to exercise this option it shall terminate and be void.
