The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas the said F.M. Hood has executed and delivered to the said L. Jackson Green his promissory note in the sum of Six hundred and sixty-five Dollars, with interest from maturity at the rate of eight per cent per annum, payable annually, and if not so paid to draw interest at the same rate as the principal—said note to be paid as follows:

\$10.00 on the 1st. day of February, 1910 and \$10.00 on the 1st., day of each month thereafter until said note and interest is paid in full.
