NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Five dollars (\$5.00) to us in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greenville, Spartanburg & Anderson Railway Company, its successors and assigns, a strip of land extending through our tracts of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, lying on the proposed line of railway, said strip measuring fifty feet in width on each side of the center of proposed railway, for railway purposes.

Bounded lands of Pelzer Manfg Co. and T.J. Garrison. The G.S. & A. Ry. Co. agrees to cut & cord wood on right of way also to fence line through our pesture and make all necessary cattle ways.

TOGETHER with the right to cut and remove any trees or timber outside of said strip which may endanger the line of railway or the wires and poles and other appliances connected with the use of said railway. Said railway is to be hereafter located by said Railway Company, but in such way as not to interfere with the use of any buildings, yards or stables now located on our premises.
