Elizabeth D. Watson, of the same place

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elizabeth D. Watson, all that lot of land situate, lie and be in the City and County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, on the south side of Main Street between Carrier street and Stone Avenue, with the following lines: Beginning at an iron stake on the west line of North Main street, two hundred and thirty-five feet from the north corner of Carrier and Main street being the North-east corner of a lot bargained by me to W. H. Hammett and running thence N. 77 1/4 W. two hundred and forty-six feet to an iron stake in the east side of east alley. Thence with said alley N. 13 E. Fifty-eight feet to an iron stake in P. G. Slopers line; thence with P. G. Sloper's line S. Eighty-five and one half E. Eighty-three feet to an iron stake in J. P. Goodwin's line. Thence with J. P. Goodwin's line S. seventy-seven degrees E. One hundred and Seventy-two feet to an iron stake in the west line of Main street; thence with Main street S. 19 1/2 W. seventy-five feet to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining to HAVE, AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Elizabeth D. Watson, her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Elizabeth D. Watson, her

Heirs and Assigns, against and every Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
