in the State aforesaid, Dollars, to suey in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
H. W. Hause of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
the said H. W. Hause all that piece of land or tract of land consisting
of two lots situated on the south-west corner of Pinckney
and Frank streets in the City and County of Greenville in
the State aforesaid, and known as lots (#14) Fourteen and
(#15) Fifteen on a plan of the property of the J. P. K. Bryant
made by Elasley in March 1901, and recorded in office
R. M. L. for Greenville County in Volume 26, page 838
reference being had to said plan the metes and bounds will
more fully appear as follows: Beginning at the south-
west corner of Frank street and Pinckney street; thence
with Pinckney street S 34° 10' E One Hundred and seventy
five (175) feet to an alley; thence with said alley S 07° 10'
One Hundred and ten (110) feet to a stake; thence N. 34° 10'
W One Hundred and seventy-five (175) feet to a stake on
Frank street; thence with old unmentioned street N. 07° E.
One Hundred and ten (110) feet to the Beginning corner
containing 19480 square feet, more or less.
