(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Augustus I. Fowler, all that piece of land or tract of land, situated, lying and being in Dates Township, County and State of aforesaid, adjoining lands of G. D. Nicoll & S. C. written, and others, containing eleven (11) acres more or less, and having the following premises and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone 3x out. up road, and running thence $\frac{1}{2}$ N. $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 204 ft. to a stone 3x out. thence $\$66\frac{1}{4}$ N. $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 340 to a stone 3x out. thence $\$60\frac{1}{4}$ N. $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 55 to a stone 3x out. thence $\$56\frac{1}{4}$ N. $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 214 to a stone 3x out. thence $\$63\frac{1}{4}$ N. $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 15 to a stone 3x out. thence $\$12\frac{1}{2}$ N. $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 50 to a stone 3x out. on Old Line, thence N. 16 E. 18. 90 to a stone 3x out. in road. thence with each mentioned road N. 36 W. 60 to the beginning corner. Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
