Houston, that certain Lot of Land in Greenville City, said County and State on the South side of Harrington Street and on the West side of Green Avenue, Beginning at a Stake on Harrington Street and thence along said street NNE 1/4 80 feet to a stake, thence S 28° 27' 16" feet to a stone railing stone, thence S 77 1/2° E 81 1/2 feet, thence N 28° E 159 feet to the Beginning being the same lot conveyed to me by the other heirs and distributees of our mother, Louisa Smith, all being of full age, on the day of January 1890 recorded in P. M. L. office for said County and State in Book No. 11, page 507 and being my one fourth interest in the lot deeded over to my mother Louisa Smith by H. C. Markley on January 4, 1884 recorded in P. M. And do hereby bind me and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said L. D. Houston, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
