all that certain piece, parcel, or plantation, of land situate, lying, and being in State and County aforesaid, on both sides Kattoras Creek, waters of South Saluda, River suppose to contain One hundred and fifty acres, (150) more or less, the same being a portion of land conveyed my Mother Mary L. Talley by George W. Keith, will the balance being a tract conveyed Mary L. Talley by Simeon E. Burgess. said land bounded by Thomas Clark, Martha Clark, Nancy E. Ferguson and others

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said John A. Burgess, his Heirs and Assigns forever

And I do hereby bind my-self and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said John A. Burgess, his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
