John R. Campbell of Greenville County State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John R. Campbell all that piece parcel and tract of land, situated lying and being in State

and aforesaid and in Dunklin Township and lying on the Public Road leading by J. L. Campbell's also on the Public Road leading to Scott's Mill place and on a branch of Horse Creek waters of Reedy River. Bounded by lands of Williams D. Snipes and the within named Jas. L. Campbell.

Containing Thirty (30 9/10) and 9/10 Acres, more or less. Having the following lines to wit: Beginning at Stone XIII O.M. on North side of Scott Mill Road, thence S. 80. 1/2 W. 24. 66 to stone XIII N.M. beyond a small branch, thence N. 41 W. 5. 10 to Stone XIII N.M. thence N. 87 W. 6. 44 to Stone XIII N.M. in edge of Campbell Road, thence N. 8 W. 9. 40 to Stone XIII on North side of Scott Mill Road, thence N. 75 E. 9. 66 to Stone XIII N.M. then S. 27 1/2 E. 2. 70 to stone XIII O.M. in Old Road bed thence along road S. 79 1/2 E. 5. 83 to Station, thence S. 76 1/2 E. 11. 15 to station, thence S. 54 1/2 E. 10. 00 to the beginning. It being a part of the same tract of land that I bought from Anna Miller by deed bearing date January 21st 1891 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Book X.X. Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
