W. Hill, A. Force, Alex Satterwhite and W. Gray Pastor and deacons of Pack's Chapel

Baptist Church, all that piece parcel, or lot of land lying, being and situate in the State and County aforesaid, just out side of the City of Greenville, in Stradleyville and containing seventeen hundred and sixty-eight square feet and has the following marks, bearings and distances, to wit; beginning on an iron pin 3 X nm on alley; thence S. 67-3/4 E. 26 feet to an iron pin 3 X 0m; thence N. 22- 7/8 E. 68 feet to an iron pin 3 X 0m; thence N. 67-3/4 W. 26 feet to an iron pin 3 X nm; thence S. 22-7/8 W. 68 feet to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of Fannie Poe, Dr. Pack, Alex Saterwhite and H.S. Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
