(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lizzie Thompson, all that piece, parcel or tract of land, lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid and in Paris Mountain Township, on Reedy-River and containing twenty-seven and nine-tenths (27-9/10) acres, more or less, and has the following marks, bearings and distances, to wit; Beginning on a stone 3 X nm on Reedy River; thence S. 73-1/2 W. 23.80 to a stone 3X nm; thence S 16-1/2 E. 5.00 to a spanish oak 3 X om (now a stone); thence S. 16-1/4 W. 10.50 to a stone 3 X om; thence S. 74-1/4 E. 3.94 to a stone 3 X om; thence N. 52-1/2 E. 30.00 to a stone 3 X om on Reedy river; thence up the meanderings of said river to the beginning corner this tract is known as tract No. 6, of the Estate of Thomas Thompson, deceased as shown by plat made by Jno M.
