Allison, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward One of the City of Greenville, fronting Seventy-five feet on Buncombe Street and extending sixty-eight and one half feet along Echols Street and a ten foot alley to lot conveyed by J.W. Gray, Master, to Willie Slowe on the 25th, day of May, 1905, being the North-east corner of Lot No.1, of which Lewis Slowe died, seized and possessed and the same conveyed to me by J.W. Gray, Master on the 25th, day of May, 1905; deed recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in book K.K.K., page 137.

And I do hereby bind my-self, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Wm. G. Sirrine and W.A. Allison, their

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
