Mills, all that tract or parcel of land situated and being in Highland Township, and in Greenville County, and in the above said State, the said tract containing twenty acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds the said land also being on the waters of Beaverdam Creek begining at a stake by a persimon tree, on the bank of said Creek and running thence S 76-1/2 W 6.20 to a stone thence N 9-1/4 E 26.40 to a stone thence N 76-1/2 E 6 chains to a white Oak, thence up the meanderings of said creek to the begining corner adjoining lands of W.T. Henson and J.M. Mills and others

TOGETHER will all and singular the Rights, Members, Heraditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said R.B. Mills and his Heirs and Assigns forever

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said R.B. Mills and his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
