the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release into the said Lewis W. Parker All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds to wit; Beginning at an iron pin on McBee Avenue and running; thence N. 69.10 E. 156 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14-1/2 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 69.10 W. 156 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 14-1/2 W. 175 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed by said R.L. Walker to said S.L. Richardson, and known as lots No. 13 and 14 of the Cleveland Lands. See Judgement Roll, 2948.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.
