and County and State aforesaid, fronting on Nichols Street, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on Nichols Street, about sixty-six feet from the corner of Nichols and Means Street, west of the said corner, and running thence in a line parallel, or nearly so with Means Street, but about seventy-six west of same, fifty-five feet to the corner of lot sold to Mary Grimes; thence in a line parallel with Nichols Street forty feet to a stake; thence in a line nearly parallel with first line fifty-five feet to a stake on Nichols Street; thence along Nichols Street thirty-two feet to the beginning corner, On said lot is a one-story, one room building now being used for holding Church services.
