ers, and Elizabeth Rogers, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward One in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:- Beginning at an iron pin on Hampton Avenue, thence along said Avenue S. 63 E. 57 to an iron pin on John T. Bramlett's line; thence along said line N. 28 E. 105 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence along Madden's line N. 65 1/2 W. 62 feet to an iron pin; thence along Mary E. Maxwell's lot S. 24 W. 104 1/2 feet to the beginning containing 6,100 square feet more or less and being same conveyed to said Norwood National Bank of Greenville, by Mary E.
