Whereas W.H. Lyles, B.M. Shuman, T.Q. Donaldson and J.W. Quattlebaum, a committee appointed by the State Convention of the Baptist Denomination in South Carolina, did at the regular session of said Convention held in the City of Spartanburg in the year 1906, report that for the purpose of separating the Greenville Female College from Furman University and putting said College under a separate Board of Trustees, the title to the land on which the buildings of the Greenville Female College now stand, being the tract of land hereinafter described, should be conveyed to The State Convention of the Baptist Denomination in South Carolina by the Trustees of Furman University on condition that said The State Convention of the Baptist Denomination in South Carolina shall in all time to come keep up and maintain in the City of Greenville, S.C. a school for males and females where all the branches of education usually pursued in a male and female academy shall be taught which shall be open to all the females of the Community of the white race as the Greenville Academies were, and in consideration of said Convention keeping up and maintaining such school; and that to enable the said The State Convention of the Baptist Denomination in South Carolina to keep up and maintain such school, the Greenville Female College should be incorporated under the name of Greenville Female College, and, in addition to the usual powers of College for girls and women, it be given the power and right to teach those branches of learning usually tought in female academies; and that it be under the control and management of a Board of Trustees elected by said Convention, whose term of office shall continue for such time as shall be determined by said Convention, and whose successors shall be elected by said Convention perpetually, and whereas the said Convention at said session accepted said report, and passed a resolution that a deed be prepared of the said land to the said The State Convention of the Baptist Denomination in South Carolina with the trusts and conditions mentioned in the said report and that The Trustees of Furman University upon the Preparation of said deed forthwith executed and delivered the same to the said The State Convention of the Baptist Denomination in South Carolina, thus conveying the same to the said -
