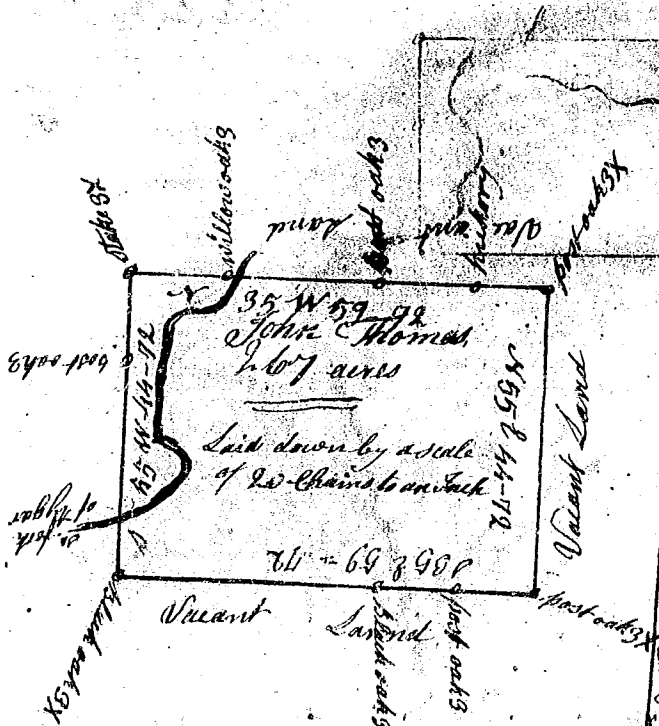
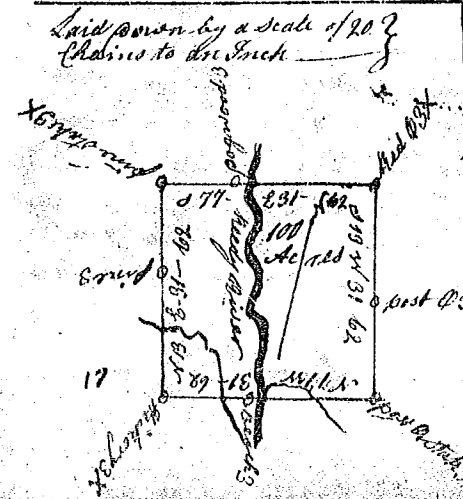


State of South Carolina

 Pursuant to a warrant from under the hand & seal of John Thomas Esq^r Commissioner of Locations on the north side of Saluda river bearing date the first day of June 1784 I have admeasured & laid out unto John Thomas a tract of land lying & being on both sides of the south fork of Needy River above the old Indian boundary, and hath such shape form & marks as the above plat represents.

 Pursuant to an warrant from John Thomas Esq^r Commissioner of Locations dated the 9th of June 1784 I have admeasured and laid out unto Abraham Case a tract of land containing one hundred acres situated in ninety six pistrict west of the old Indian Boundary on both sides of Needy River about one mile above the big cain creek bounded on all sides by vacant land, and hath such form and marks as the above plat represents
