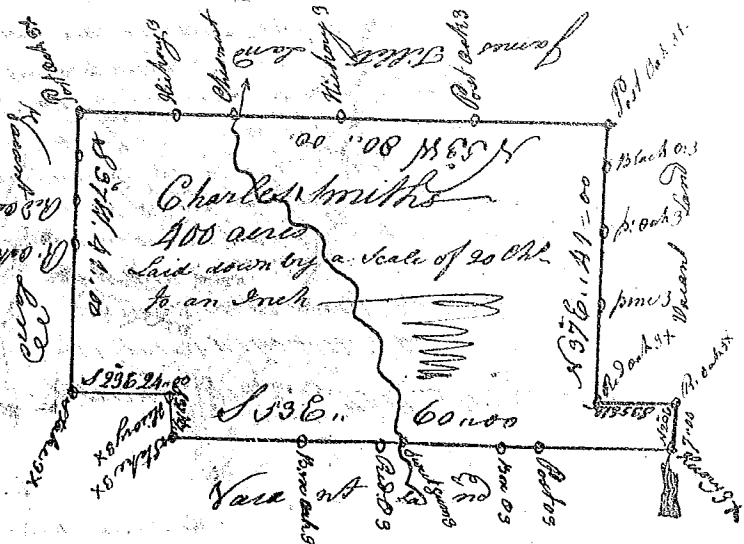

John Smith a Tract of Land containing two Hundred

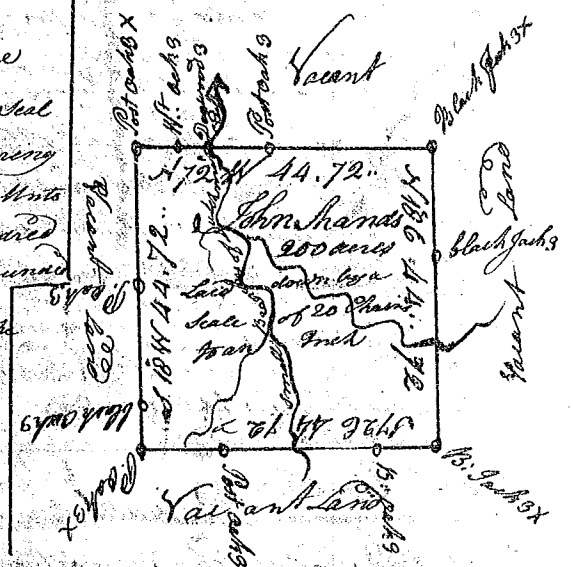

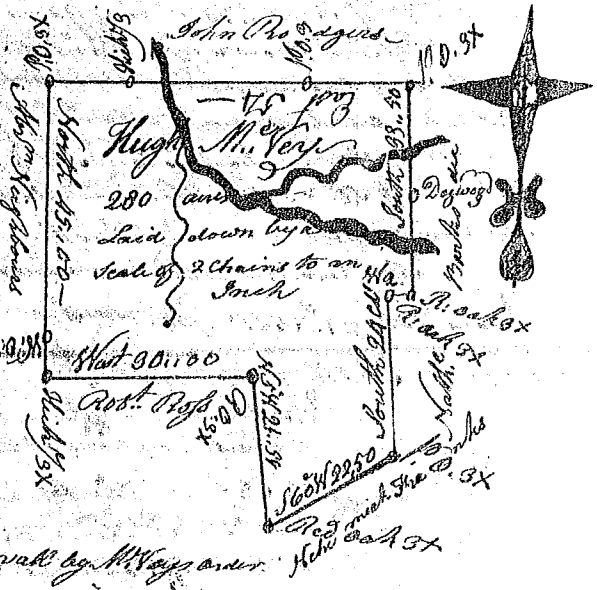
