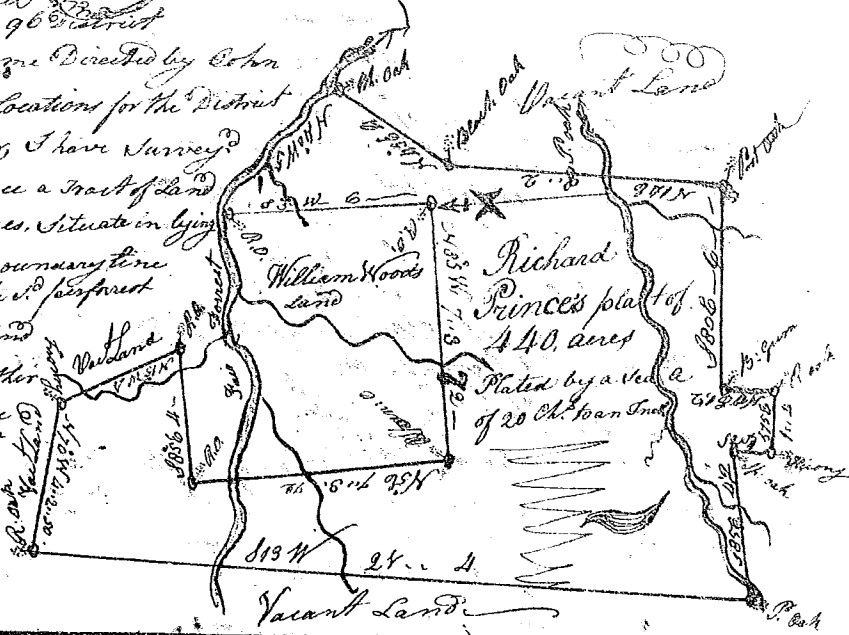


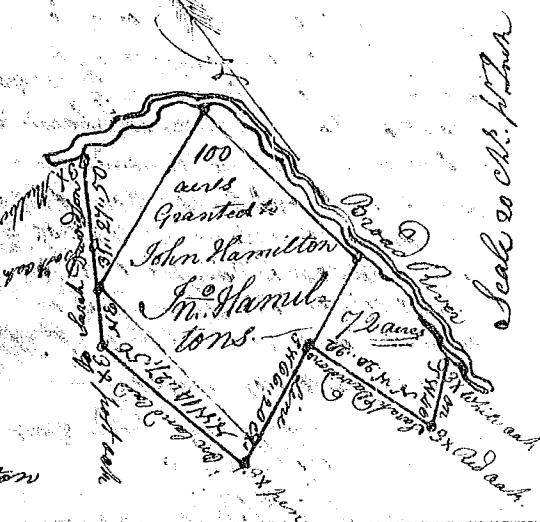

Pursuant to a Warrant from John Thomas Esq^r Commissioner of Locations I have Admeasured and laid out unto St. John Hamilton a tract of Seventy two acres of Land, Situate in Ninety six District on Broad River Bounding S.W. on land laid out to Sarah Davidson all other sides on ~~Vacant~~ land laid out and hath such shaks and marks as the Annexed plat Represents. Surveyed the 4th day of Sept^r 1784 D. H. Stephens

State of South Carolina Ninety six District

On the East side of the Ancient Boundary line Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq^r Commissioner of Locations Directed on the North side of Saluda River bearing date August 9th 1784 I have Admeasured and laid out unto James Brown a Tract of Land containing one thousand & Ninety acres, lying on a small branch of Enoree called bush head creek. Bounding S.W. by Joseph Patterson's land all other other sides Vacant Land Proper & hath such shaks and marks as the Annexed plat Represents. Surveyed 13th of August 1784 by me
