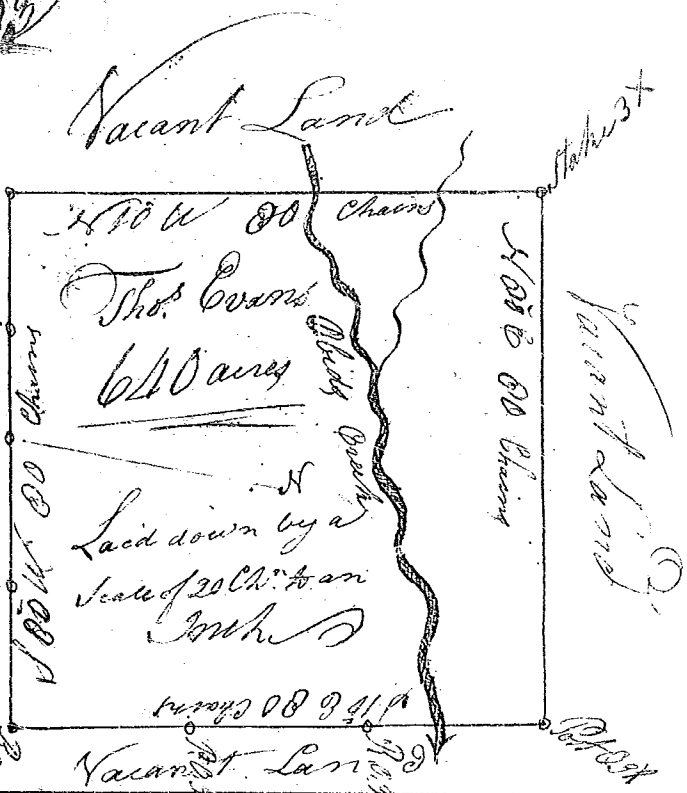

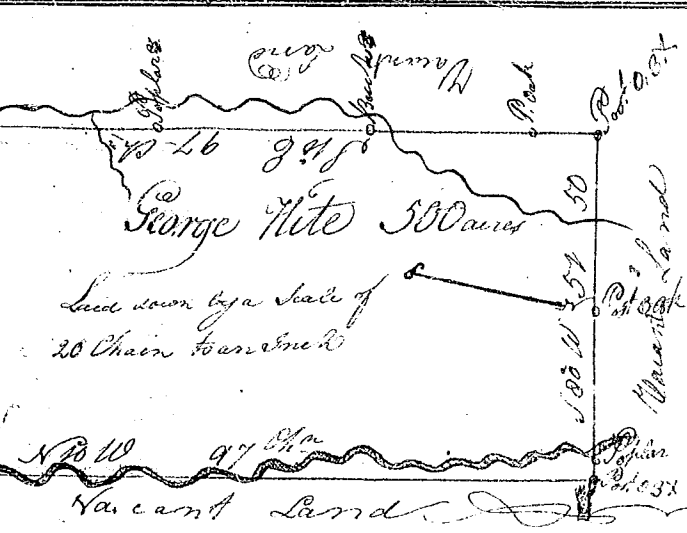

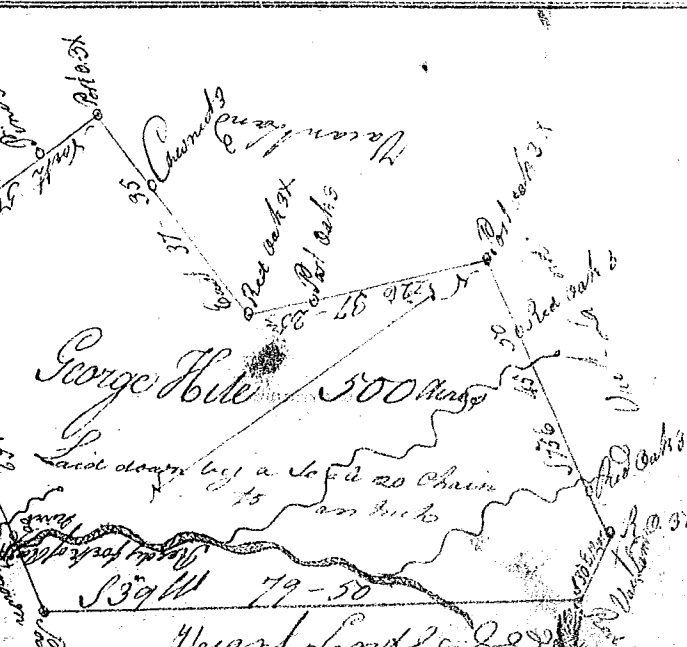

Bounding West & E. on land Not known, and all other sides Vacant Land and hath such shape and marks as the annexed plat represents. Survey this 28th July 1784
