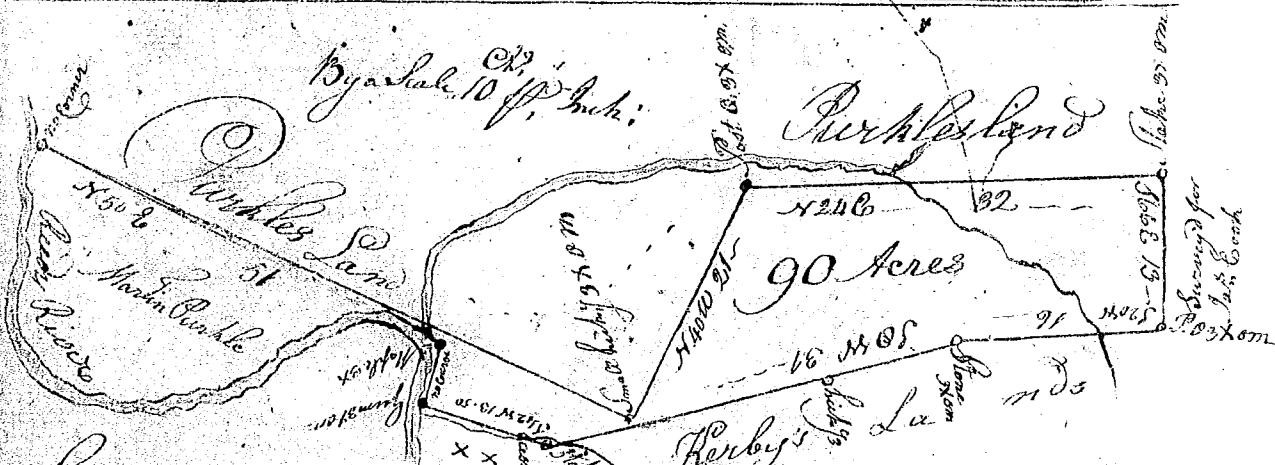
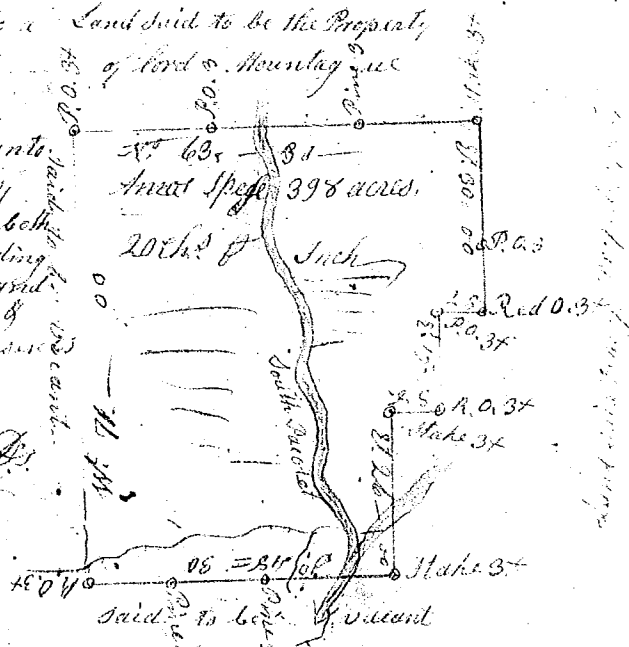


South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq.
