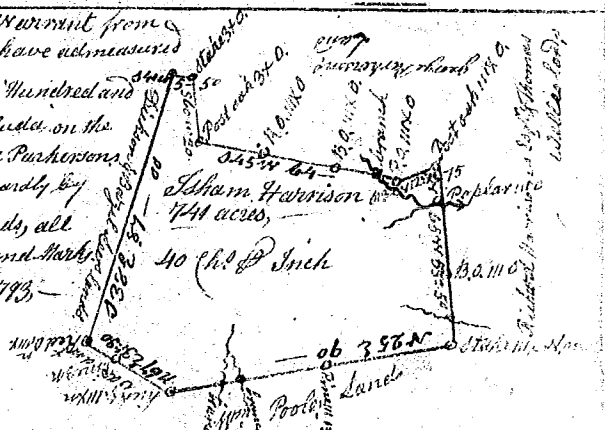

 measured and laid out unto Nathan Hawkins a tract of four hundred and  
 four<sup>th</sup> hundred acres of land in Pinkney District, Union County on Fancher Creek Inclusion of  
 a mill shoal, bounded by above running N.E. John Cooks and John Barge's Land, by  
 a line running N.W. by Isaac Cooks Land originally, but now the land of Nathan Hawkins  
 and land survey<sup>d</sup> by John Barge, & by a line running S.W. on John Barge's Land & by a line  
 running S.E. on Thomas M. Donald's Land, and hath such shape, form & Mark as the

 S. 85° & N. 5 W. by John Lewis's Land, all other sides by  
 vacant lands, and hath such form and Mark as
