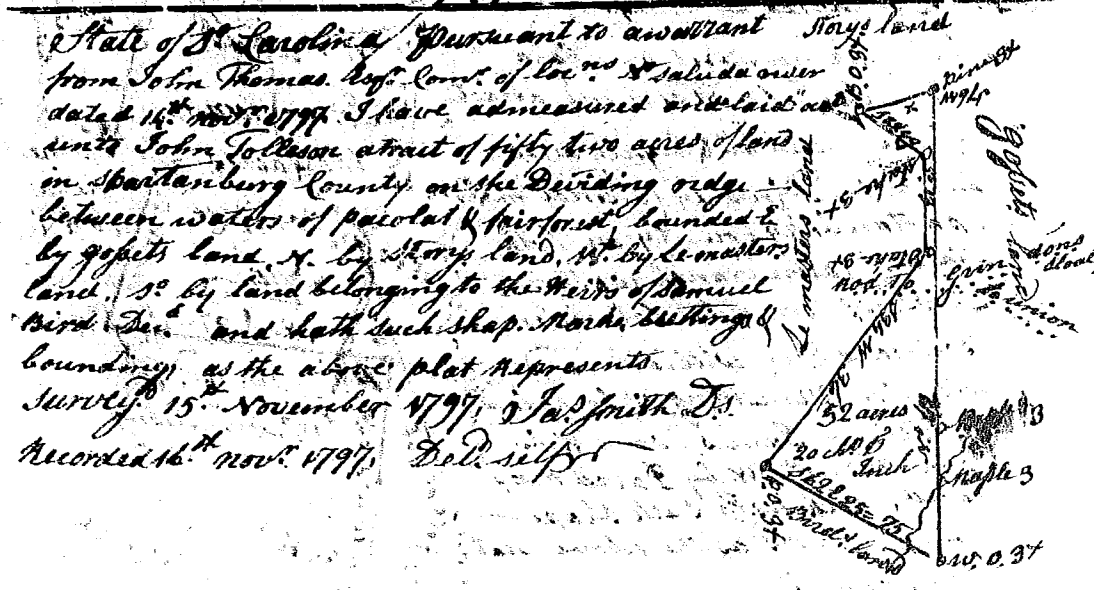




Land Granted to Abraham  
 State of S. Carolina

Pursuant to a Warrant  
 from John Thomas Com<sup>rs</sup> Sec<sup>y</sup> of S. Carolina  
 dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1796  
 I have admeasured & laid out unto William  
 Austin a tract of One Hundred Acres of land. Situated in  
 Greenville County of State afores<sup>d</sup>, On the S<sup>e</sup> side of Giddens creek  
 Waters of Noice river, & on some branches of said creek, bounded  
 by lines running S E by said Austin's own land N. W. & S E, by land  
 Mashley N W by Daniel Wrights land N E by Bearrings Chandless  
 land & S E by William Vaughans land & hath such shape form  
 marks Buttings & boundings as the above plat represents  
 Survey'd the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1796, J<sup>o</sup> Pilgore S<sup>r</sup>  
 Recorded the 15<sup>th</sup> Nov, 1797 Del. self

 dated 15<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup> 1797 I have admeasured & laid out  
 unto John Tolleson a tract of fifty two acres of land  
 in Spartanburg County on the dividing ridge  
 between waters of parolat & first forest bounded E  
 by gophers land N. by Storys land W. by Leonarders  
 land S<sup>e</sup> by land belonging to the heirs of Samuel  
 Bird Den and hath such shape marks buttings &  
 boundings as the above plat represents  
 Survey'd 15<sup>th</sup> November 1797 J<sup>o</sup> Smith S<sup>r</sup>  
 Recorded 16<sup>th</sup> Nov<sup>r</sup> 1797 Del. self
