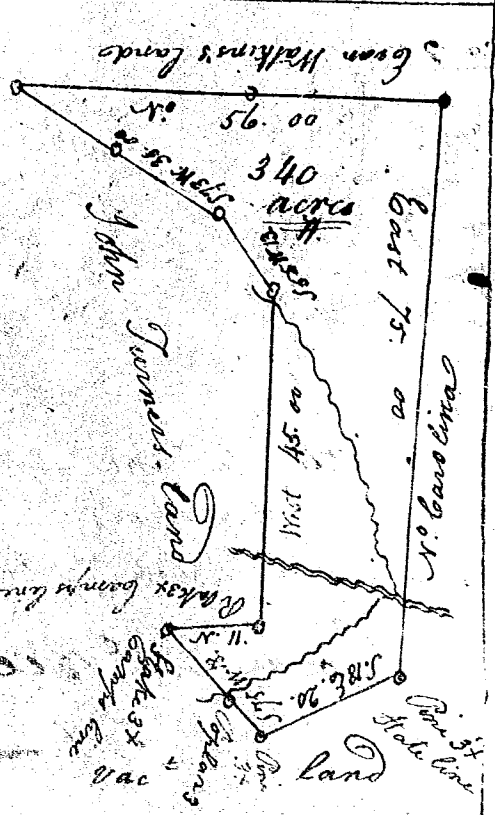


State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina
