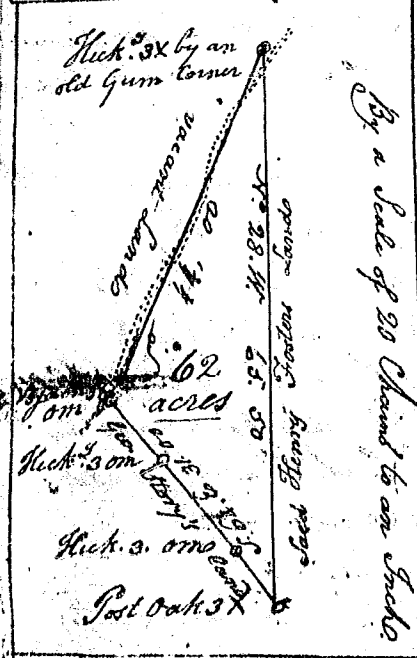


State of S<sup>o</sup> Carolina

Com<sup>r</sup> of Locations N<sup>o</sup> Saluda, dated the Eleventh day of July 1793 I have admeasured and laid out unto Larkin Lancaster a tract of two Hundred & twelve acres of Land in Spartanburg County on the North Side of Dutchmans Creek of Tygar River, Bounded Eastwardly & Northwardly by James Bennetts Land Northwardly & Westerly by Sam. Lancasters Land, Westwardly and Eastwardly by Thomas Evatts Land, Westwardly & Southwardly By W<sup>m</sup> Bratchers Land, all other sides by Vacant Land and hath such Shape and marks as the above plat Represents

Henry Fosters Land, on the N<sup>o</sup> by George Storrs Land and on the East by Vacant Land. It hath such Shape and marks as the above plat Represents.
