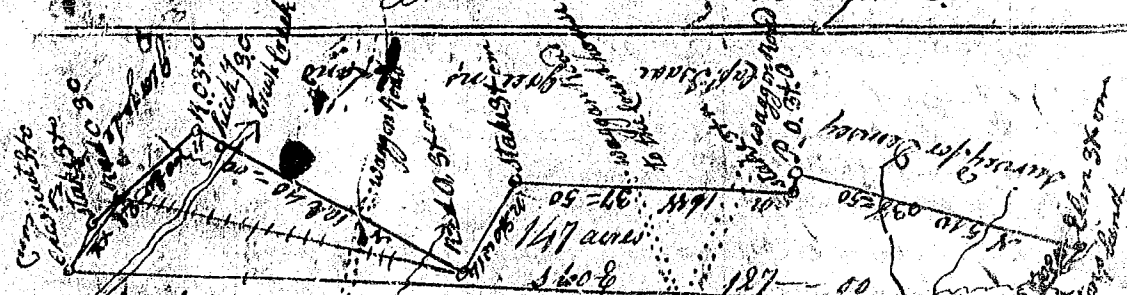

land all other sides vacant, - and hath such shape & marks as
the above Plat represents, Surveyed 14th June 1799

own land N.E. & N.W. by George Lewis's land, & hath such shape, form
and marks as the above plat represents, Surveyed 20th June 1799
