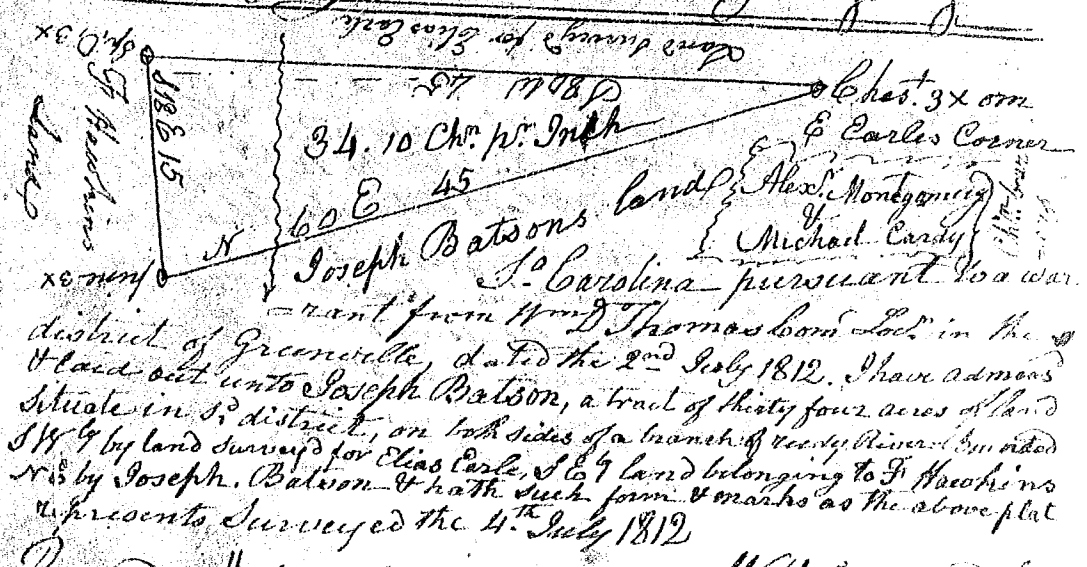


South Carolina of

 S^{ly} by land surveyed for Elias Cole, S^{ly} land belonging to F. Macoskins
 N^o by Joseph. Batson & hath such form & marks as the above plat
 represents. Surveyed the 4th July 1812
