 from John Young Esq. Commissioner of Locations  
 dated the 15th day of August 1818, I have administered  
 and laid out for Nelson Dickerson a tract of Land  
 containing four hundred and fifty eight Acres  
 Situate in the said District, lying on the  
 branches of the Golden Grove and Ruddy Fork  
 waters of Saluda and Ruddy Rivers, bounded  
 by a line running N 11 W on James Dickerson's  
 Land N on James Farmer & Wm Smith's N 6 on  
 William Raney's Land, and on all other sides on  
 Land unknown, and hath such form and marks  
 as the above Plat represents,  
 Survey'd the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1818  
 Recorded the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1818, Benj<sup>r</sup> Arnold D. S.
