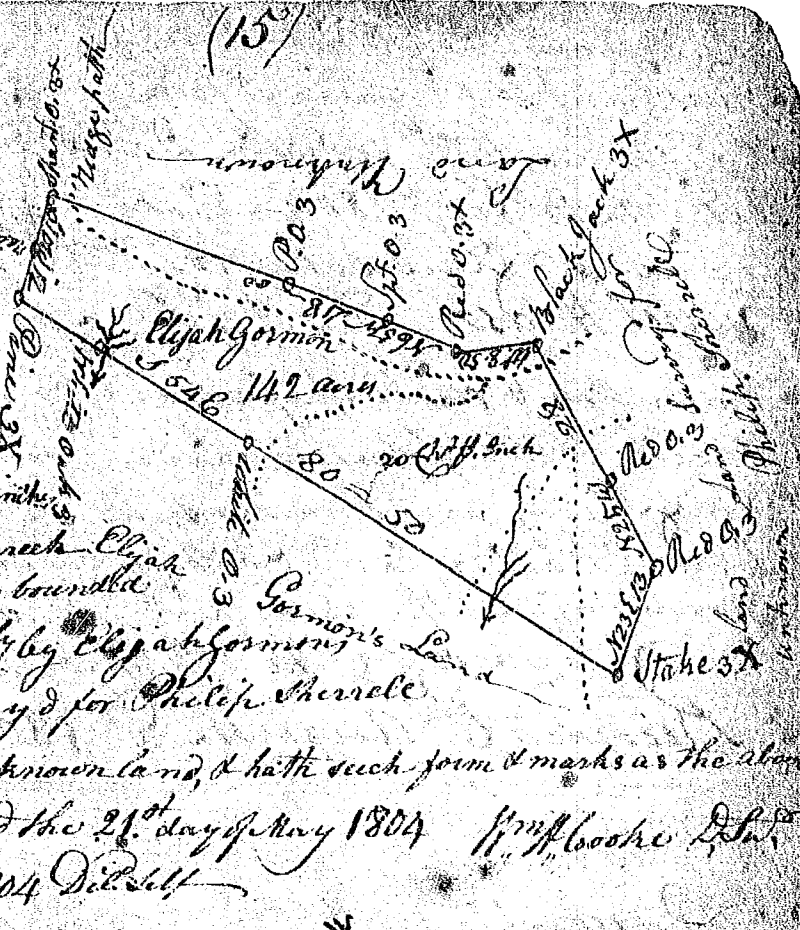

I have measured & laid out unto Elijah Gorman a tract of land containing one hundred & forty two acres - Situate in the said District, on the head branch of the mallow fork of the creek - Elijah Gorman's Land bounded by a line running S 67° E by Elijah Gorman's Land, N 74° E by land surveyed for Philip Sherrell & on all other sides by unknown land, & hath such form & marks as the above plat represents - Surveyed the 21st day of May 1804 Wm. H. Cooke Esq. R. recorded this 19th July 1804 D. H. H.

Pursuant to a warrant from Wm. D. Thomas Com. Ld. in the dist. of Greenville dated the 11th day of June 1804, I have measured & laid out unto Johnson - Baen, a tract of land containing one hundred and eighteen acres - Situate in the said District, on the ridge between the waters of Saluda & Pacolet (rivers) bounded by a line running S 67° E by Land surveyed for Michael McElorath North by land unknown and on all other sides by vacant land including an improvement where Johnson Baen now liveth, & hath such form & marks as the above plat represents - Surveyed the 11th June 1804 Wm. H. Cooke Esq. R. recorded this first day of August 1804.
