Pursuant to a warrant from John C. Young Esq. Commissioner of Locations in the District of Greenville dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1820, I have admeasured and laid out unto Iron Springfield a tract of land containing 53<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> acres, situate in Greenville District, on both sides of Beckhorn Creek waters of Enoree River; bounded N.W. & S.W. by Halls lands, lands belonging to the Big Survey, Brookshy land, and unknown, all other sides by adjacent lands and hath such form and marks as the above Plat represents, Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1820,
