I have admeasured & laid out unto Sam<sup>l</sup> Williams one hundred and fourteen acres of land, and in said Survey, surveyed seven hundred and eighty eight acres originally granted to Robert Maxwell, for the purpose of obtaining a new Grant, situated in the District aforesaid, on the rocky fork of Golden Grove Creek, waters of Saluda River, and hath such for an and marks, Bearings and soundings, as the above Plat represents, — Surveyed the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1831, by Sam<sup>l</sup> Moore D<sup>y</sup>, — Recorded the 11<sup>th</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1831.
