Pursuant to a warrant from John Young Esq. Comr. of Locals, in the District of Greenville dated the 22^d day of Feb^r 1832, I have admeasured and laid out into lots a tract of Land containing eight hundred acres, situate in said District on waters of the North fork of Saluda River bounded by lines running N 8 by Land surveyed for Samuel Lister, by North Carolina line, S 8 by The Barton's Land All other sides by Vacant Land, and half such form and parts as the above Plat represents surveyed the 22^d day of Feb^r 1832, and recorded the 23^d day of March 1832.
