



South Carolina. Pursuant to a warrant from John Watson Esq. Comptroller of the district of Greenville dated the 25th of April 1836 for the purpose of locating lands heretofore granted and vacant land (if any) I have advanced and laid out unto Alexander McKinnon a tract of land containing five hundred and forty four acres situate in said district on both sides of the Middle fork waters of the Saluda River bounded S. W. by Bellulimus & unknown land J. E. unknown, N. E. by said McKinnon's land and vacant & N. W. by McKinnon's being two lots one originally granted to David Norris on tract originally granted to Thomas Wood and the residue unknown and hath such form and marks as the above plat represents. Surveyed the 7th day of May 1836.
