



South Carolina - Pursuant to a Warrant from William Blasingame Esquire Commissioner of Location in the District of Greenville dated the first day of March 1841 I have admeasured and laid out unto William Tucker a Tract of Land containing One hundred and Sixteen Acre, situate in said District on some small branches of Oil Camp Creek water of the middle fork of Saluda River bounded by line running NW. by said Tucker's land and vacant Land N.E. and S.E. by land owned and known S.W. by Hugh Potts land having such form and marks, buttings and bounding as the above plat represents.
