Pursuant to a warrant from William Blainings Esq Commissioner of Locations for the District of Greenville dated the fourth day of March 1842 I have measured and laid out into Abielon Wylke a tract of three thousand six hundred acres of land situate in the Districts of Greenville & Pickens on both sides of the mouth of Saluda <sup>river</sup> bounded by lines running N.E. by land belonging to the heirs of John Caro for 6000. Abraham Bledsoe. N.W. and S.W. by A. Cleveland and vacant land. S.W. by Benj. Wood's land N.E. and N.W. by Marseus land. S.W. by Henry Stormons and heirs of Thomas Rowland including several grants originally granted to different individuals and also a small quantity of land heretofore vacant, and assuming for the purpose of obtaining a new grant, having such form and marks as the above plat represents - Surveyed March 5<sup>th</sup> 1842 John C. Dorr - D.S.
