Pursuant to a warrant from William Blount Esq. Commissioner of Locations in the District of Greenville dated the first day of February 1844 I have surveyed and laid out unto John H. Goodwin a tract of six thousand acres of land situate in said District on the East side of the North Fork of Saluda River bounded by lines running N. E. & S. E. of Joseph Goodwin John Cox's William Coxes William Lynches John Lynches Prosser, Lambles and Jefferson Crommels land N. W. & S. W. by Jesse Crommels and James Pickette Paul S. W. by John Martins land S. W. & N. W. by John C. Wightman, Land S. W. & West by the north fork of Saluda River John C. Wightman, John Poyes and Joseph Goodwin's Land including parts of several grants originally granted to John Clayton William Lynch and others including also a small triangle never before granted. The object of the present survey being to obtain a new grant for the whole. The whole having such farms and marks buildings and buildings as the above plat represents.
