NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, THAT

H & H Glass Service, Inc. is due the sum of Three Thousand,
Five Hundred and No/100 (\$3,500.00) Dollars from CBR, Inc. a statement of a just
and true account of said indebtedness, with all just credits given, being attached
hereto and made a part hereof, to gether with interest from the 7th day of November,
1974.

That said debt is due the undersigned for labor performed or
furnished, and/or for materials furnished, and actually used in the erection, alteration
or repair of buildings or structures situated on or in otherwise improving, the real
estate hereinafter described, by virtue of an agreement with, or by consent of, CBR,
Inc., the owner thereof, or a person or persons authorized by or rightfully acting for,
said owner or said debt is due the undersigned because such improvements have been
authorized by said owner. That, as shown by the attached statement, the undersigned
labored on, or furnished labor and materials for such buildings, structures or improve-
ments within ninety (90) days of the date thereof, to-wit, on or after the 7th day of
November, 1974.

That by virtue thereof, by the service and filing of this Notice
and Certificate, and pursuant to the provisions of the Statutes in such cases made and
provided, the undersigned hs and claims a lien to secure the payment of the debt so
due and the costs of enforcing said lien upon the buildings or structures herein above
mentioned and upon the following described real estate:

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land, with the buildings and
improvements thereon, lying and being near the City of
Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
being in the intersection of Rangeview Circle and White Horse
Road and containing approximately six (6) acres, more or less.
This is the same property shown on its auditor's Block Book
recorded in School District 303 as B-13.3-1-6 and is all of the
remaining property on White Horse Road owned by the late
States W. Jolly at the time of his death.

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
