
That the Plaintiff is entitled to a warrant of attachment pursuant to the 1976 South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended, §15-19-10, et seq.

That the Defendant Carroll F. Brown as co-buyer and his son, Kevin D. Brown, as buyer, did enter into a Security Agreement dated December 12, 1978, a copy of which is attached to the Complaint in this action and incorporated herein by reference, with Plaintiff for the purchase and financing of one (1) 1979 Chevrolet pick-up truck; that the vehicle was taken to New Hampshire and disposed of, leaving the Plaintiff with no collateral or security; that no payment under the terms of the agreement was ever made and the Defendant is in default under the terms of the security agreement; that there is a present outstanding balance due Plaintiff under the terms of the agreement in the amount of Six Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Three and 58/100ths (\$6,763.58) Dollars, plus reasonable attorney fees up to 15% of the unpaid balance which is One Thousand Fourteen and 53/100ths (\$1,014.53) Dollars of which no amount has been paid.

That the above described property is presently for sale by the Defendant and a local real estate firm is attempting to sell the property.

That the Defendant does owe the Plaintiff, General Motors Acceptance Corporation the sum of Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Eight and 11/100ths (\$7,778.11) Dollars as a result of his default under the terms of the agreement and the disposal of the collateral.

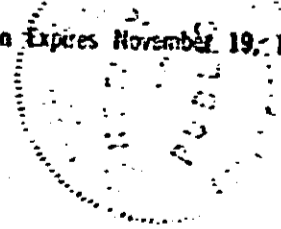
