The purpose of entering into this undertaking is to secure the release of said lien from the property. It is understood that the undersigned will not be required to perform under this undertaking unless the person filing the lien brings suit pursuant to the provisions of the Mechanics Lien Statute.

By filing this undertaking the undersigned does not admit that any sums are owing or that the lien claimant is entitled to file a lien.
