That on or about February 25, 1981, Southern Painting & Maintenance Specialists, Inc. did contract with authorization and agreement of the owner, NORMAN E. WOOD, with DAYS INN OF AMERICA, INC. and RAY MOTELS CORPORATION d/b/a DAYS INN, to supply materials and to perform painting work in the buildings located on said premises at a contract price of \$6506.00.

That the materials supplied and the labor performed under the above referred to contract were furnished with the authorization and agreement of NORMAN E. WOOD, DAYS INN OF AMERICA, INC. and RAY MOTELS CORPORATION d/b/a DAYS INN, in the performance of painting work on real property of NORMAN E. WOOD, located on the northerly side of U. S.
