II.

That heretofore on or about February 26, 1982, the personal defendant contracted with the plaintiff, who is a practicing trial lawyer in the State and County aforesaid, for legal services in connection with a domestic case brought by his wife; that in the course thereof, certain legal services were rendered to the personal defendant as indicated by the attached time sheet, marked "Exhibit A", which is hereto attached, incorporated into and made a part hereof by reference.

III.

That said personal defendant has paid toward the total bill owed of Two Thousand Five Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Seventy-Five (\$2,518.75) Cents the sum of Seven Hundred (\$700.00) Dollars, which leaves a balance due and owing of One Thousand Eight Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Seventy-Five (\$1,818.75) Cents.

IV.

That demand was made upon the personal defendant for payment of the balance owed or to make suitable arrangements for payment of same on the 26th day of July, 1982; however, said personal defendant has failed and refused to pay the balance owed or to make suitable arrangements for payment of same; that the entire balance is now past-due and owing, no part of which has been paid by cash, discount, interest or otherwise; and that your plaintiff is informed and believes that he is entitled to judgment against the personal defendant for the balance owed of One Thousand Eight Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Seventy-Five (\$1,818.75) Cents.

V.

That your plaintiff further seeks an attachment against the real-property interest of the personal defendant in the above-described real property in order that there may be some security to pay any judgment which the plaintiff may obtain in this cause.
