ORDER DISCHARGING MECHANIC'S
LIEN AND DISMISSING DEFENDANT
CINCINNATI MILACRON, INC.

THIS MATTER COMES BEFORE ME in accordance with
Order rendered by the Honorable E. C. Burnett, Presiding
Judge, Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, on May 25, 1982,
directing that Henry Filters, Inc. and Les Todd and Son,
Inc. be joined as additional parties defendant in the
above-captioned action. The Order further directed that
after Henry Filters and Les Todd and Son, Inc. had answered
or otherwise plead thereto and a written undertaking in the
sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars
(\$14,537.00) had been deposited to the Clerk of Court of
Greenville County, pursuant to Section 29-5-110, Code of
Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended, Cincinnati
Milacron, Inc. be dismissed as a defendant herein. Upon
deposit by Cincinnati Milacron, Inc., of the aforementioned
undertaking, the Mechanic's Lien filed in Mechanic's Lien
Book 18, Page 1335, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville
County directed to Cincinnati Milacron, Inc., would be
discharged and released.

Henry Filters, Inc. and Les Todd and Son, Inc. have
been properly served with Summons and Complaint and allowed
twenty (20) days to answer or otherwise plead. It now
appears that both Henry Filters, Inc. and Les Todd and Son,
