


That the Plaintiff, supplied labor and/or materials for the benefit of the Defendants used in the construction and erection of the New Greenville Holiday Inn located on the real property more fully described above. That Plaintiffs furnished labor and/or materials from August of 1984 through the last date of November 29, 1984. Plaintiff was to receive compensation therefor from Defendant through Barge-Wagner Contractors, Defendant's contractor for said construction.

Barge-Wagner, Defendant's contractor, forced Plaintiff to leave the construction site without paying Plaintiff for the labor and/or materials furnished to Defendants by Plaintiff.

The reasonable price of such labor so performed and materials so furnished was and is Fifty Two Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-two Dollars and 71/100 (\$52,282.71). All payments having been made have been credited and the full amount of the above sum is due for which sum Plaintiff now claims a Mechanics Lien on the said structure known as the New Greenville Holiday Inn and the land on which the same is situated, as well as for attorney's fees and the costs of said Mechanics Lien.
