

3. Upon information and belief, Fred Gunther and Steve Shapo are some of the officers and/or directors of SIS who reside in Fort Worth, Johnson-Tarrant Counties, Texas.

4. Upon information and belief, Western Preferred Corporation (WPC) is a Colorado corporation with offices in Denver, Denver County, Colorado.

5. Upon information and belief, Fred Gunther, Steve Brezeale, Steve Shapo, Raymond Dickerson, Burl Godfrey, Gene Fisher, Thomas Brown, Ransom Jones, F. Larry Tunnell, Lawrence Durbin, Richard Juneau, and Wayne Lynn are some of the officers and/or directors of WPC and all of said officers and directors are residents of Fort Worth, Johnson-Tarrant Counties, Texas, except the defendant Wayne Lynn who is, upon information and belief, a resident of Tampa, Hillsborough County, Florida.

6. Heretofore on September 29, 1982, the plaintiff (Company) and SIS (Agent) entered into an agreement entitled "General Agency Agreement" (Agreement), some pertinent parts of which read:

"The Company appoints the Agent as its authorized General Agent for the State of South Carolina to solicit and receive applications for such contracts of insurance as are listed in paragraph 1 hereof, to collect premiums, appoint sub-agents, issue and countersign policies of insurance, and to perform such other acts as General Agent for the Company as are expressly provided herein; and, the Agent does hereby accept such appointment upon the following terms, conditions and considerations...."
