AFFIDAVIT

PERSONALLY appeared before me Thomas W. Styron, who, upon being duly sworn, states and deposes that:

I am Thomas W. Styron of Greenville, South Carolina, Executive Director of the Greenville County Museum of Art. On this date, the Museum has commenced an action against Rudy Allen Gary, formerly one of its internal accountants, to collect sums owed to the Museum as a result of Mr. Gary's conversion of certain of the Museum's financial assets. The amount converted directly by Mr. Gary is approximately \$135,000 and the amount constructively converted by Mr. Gary (in the form of penalties for state and federal income withholding taxes and state sales taxes that Mr. Gary failed to pay so that he could take these funds for his own benefit) is approximately \$8,000.

I am informed and believe that Mr. Gary has assigned, disposed of or secreted or is about to assign, dispose of or secrete certain of his property with an intent to defraud the Museum.

Mr. Gary is justly and truly indebted to the Greenville County Museum of Art in the approximate principal sum of \$143,000
