This being the case, the plaintiff conceded that the defendants Lempesis have an absolute defense to the mechanic's lien action.

Accordingly, the Motion of the defendants Lempesis for summary judgment is granted and this relief is also granted to the defendant Charles A. Theodore, who, although in default, is an owner of the property and therefore has the right to claim the
